Dear Mr Tamek:

Greetings on behalf of People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals—PETA entities have more than 10.4 million members and supporters worldwide. With so much violence in the prisoners' lives, let's make sure it ends at mealtime. **Will you please implement a vegan meals policy at El Arjat Prison for Ayoub Ben Nesnes, who is currently incarcerated for skinning, cooking and eating a dog, as well as for all other inmates, and then extend the policy across all prisons in Morocco?**

Prisons that serve vegan meals report calmer populations and major savings. A jail in the U.S. reported a cost reduction of over 2.5 million dirhams when it switched to all-vegetarian food for its inmates, who thrived eating fresh, quality food. Vegan menus also slash healthcare costs, since animal-free foods protect against diet-related diseases.

Vegan foods promote empathy and nonviolence. Factory farms are built on bloodshed—workers slit animals' throats, mutilate them without painkillers, and exploit mothers until their bodies collapse. By refusing to serve the products of cruelty, prisons can help stop the cycle of violence.

By offering vegan meals in El Arjat Prison and other correctional facilities across the country, Morocco can show the world that peace is possible—even in the hardest places. After all, the only peaceful meal is a vegan one. We would gladly assist your agency in creating balanced vegan menus.
